A compact and responsive platform, equipped with a compensator and an Optics Ready bolt head.

The **ARCTURUS Tempest 4.3" Hi-Capa DG GBB pistol** combines an **ORS Optics Ready** slide, a **frame-mounted compensator**, and a stabilized outer barrel. This design promotes accuracy, maintains a fast cycle time, and offers broad compatibility with **Tokyo Marui Hi-Capa** systems.

A compact architecture geared towards precision

The **ARCTURUS Tempest 4.3" Hi-Capa GBB DG** features a compact design with a 105mm inner barrel. In the field, the overall balance is immediately apparent: the replica remains responsive to handling while maintaining a configuration designed to produce consistent trajectories. The manufacturer claims a 75% success rate on a 30 x 30 cm target at 30 meters under their testing conditions.

Compensator fixed to the chassis and stabilized barrel

The **compensator** isn't simply added to the end of the replica. It's secured with screws and connected to the chassis to stabilize the outer barrel. In other words, unwanted movement is limited during the bolt cycle, which helps maintain more consistent alignment and better shot accuracy.

Fast cycle and smooth operation

The fast-cycling bolt action was designed to facilitate dynamic sequences of fire. Its responsiveness is particularly well-suited to close-quarters combat and courses requiring rapid transitions. Furthermore, the compensator mounting ensures smooth bolt operation, even when a **dummy suppressor** is installed.

ORS cylinder head compatible with several standards

The **ORS Optics Ready** slide allows for the installation of a red dot sight using an **RMR** , **RMSc** , or **DeltaPoint Pro** mount. This expanded compatibility makes it easy to create a configuration tailored to the player's preferences, whether they are looking for a compact sight window, a more generous field of view, or rapid target acquisition.

Handling of heavy balls

An additional **Hop-Up** tensioner is provided to allow the use of BBs up to **0.36g** . In practice, this adjustment helps to utilize heavier projectiles to achieve a more stable trajectory, particularly when shooting at medium range or in outdoor conditions.

A highly scalable Hi-Capa base

The manufacturer announces compatibility for approximately **70% of parts** and **100% of Tokyo Marui Hi-Capa sets** . This architecture opens up numerous customization possibilities while maintaining a coherent base right out of the box. It's exactly the kind of platform that allows for gradual progression without having to start from scratch.

Which optics are compatible with the ORS bolt head?

The ORS bolt is compatible with red dot sights using RMR, RMSc and DeltaPoint Pro imprints.

What is the role of the compensator fitted to this version?

The compensator is fixed to the chassis to stabilize the outer barrel. This design helps improve consistency and maintain a smooth bolt cycle.

What weight of marbles can be used?

The additional Hop-Up tensioner supplied allows the use of BBs up to 0.36g.
